- Knowledge of key words

- Classification of landscape features as physical or man-made
- Map reading
- Extended writing on a key question.

Year 8 – January - June

Course Overview: Atlas and map reading skills / Rocks

- Writing Project : Students will complete an extended piece of writing titled 'Weather Report'
- Continuous Assessment: Students will be assessed on 4 specified homeworks each term. Each homework will be marked out of 5.
- Summer Exam: Students will be assessed on the knowledge and skills they have covered during their course. This includes:
- Knowledge of key words
- Map reading
- Drawing and interpreting graphs (including line graph, bar chart, wind rose, pictograph)
- Extended writing on a key question.
