Junior School Assessment Guidelines for Year 9 English September - June

Year 9: September - December

Course Overview: Strange and Mysterious/Suspense – based on the study of a novel

- Assessment Task: Students will produce an extended piece of creative writing.
- Continuous Assessment: Students will be assessed on specified homeworks, including reading, writing, research tasks and spellings. An overall mark out of 20 will be awarded based on quality of homeworks completed.
- Christmas Exam: Students will be assessed on key skill areas building on activities completed during the course of the term. The exam will be in three parts:
- Reading fiction showing understanding of writer's technique;
- Extended descriptive writing task;
- Punctuation task.

Year 9: January - March

Course Overview: Problems

- Assessment task: Students will be assessed on their reading skills, examining how characters are presented.
- Continuous Assessment: Students will be assessed on specified homeworks as per the first term.

Year 9: April – June

Course overview: What's in the News? / War Poetry

- Continuous Assessment: Students will be assessed on specified homeworks as per the first term. An overall mark out of 20 will be awarded to reflect the quality of homework completed.
- **Summer Exam:** Students will be assessed on the skills they have developed:
- Reading and exploring language in a news article;
- An extended writing piece, focusing on using persuasive language to promote an issue;
- A short grammar exercise
