## Junior School Assessment Guidelines for Year 9 Geography September - June

## Year 9: September - December

**Course Overview:** Atlas and map reading skills / Ecosystems

- **Geography Project:** Students will use O.S. Maps to determine the best location for a number of people.
- **Continuous Assessment:** Students will be assessed on 4 specified homeworks each term. Each homework will be marked out of 5.
- Christmas Exam: Students will be assessed on the knowledge and skills they have developed. This includes:
- Knowledge of key words
- Atlas skills being able to use the contents and index
- Four and Six figure grid references
- Measuring distance / scale
- Extended writing on a key question.

## Year 9 - January - June

Course Overview: Population / Volcanoes

- Creative Writing Project: Students will write autobiographically about an adventure in a tropical rainforest
- Continuous Assessment: Students will be assessed on 4 specified homeworks each term. Each homework will be marked out of 5.
- Christmas Exam: Students will be assessed on the knowledge and skills they have developed in their Year 9 course. This includes:
- Knowledge of keywords
- Ordnance Survey Map skills
- Annotating diagrams
- Extended writing on a key guestion.
