- **Project:** Students will carry out research to complete a presentation on the life and work of Martin Luther King. This project will be marked out of 20 marks.
- **Continuous Assessment:** Students will be assessed on 4 specified homeworks each term and this will have a total of 20 marks.
- **Summer Exam:** Students will be assessed on the knowledge and skills they have developed during their year 9 course.
 - Keywords and their meanings
 - Knowledge of the main type of prejudice that exists and issues surrounding slavery both in the past and now.
 - Knowledge of teachings about the kingdom of God from the parables Jesus taught.
 - An extended piece of writing on key questions.
