



## REMOTE LEARNING - STUDENT GUIDANCE

All work will be set via Google classroom.

When you are working at home you can still follow your school timetable, and work on the subjects you would have each day.

Your teachers will be available to help you with work during your 'class time'. You can message them on Google classroom or via email, and they will be able to respond to give you feedback or help. You shouldn't be expecting teachers to reply to emails in the evenings.

If you find it easier to work on a couple of subjects per day, or you have to share a device with a sibling, you can do so.

You need to upload work for the deadline set by your teacher. You can either upload the google document, upload a word document or take a photo of handwritten work.

Teachers will mark and assess your work regularly.

If you are sick and can't complete work that day, ask a parent to send a message to your Form Tutor who can let you teachers know.
